Dr. Wu was named Vice President/Chief Scientist for Spirit AeroSystems, Inc., upon the divestiture of the Boeing Commercial Airplanes Wichita Division, in June 2005, where he had served as a Boeing Senior Technical Fellow since 2001.

While with Boeing, Dr. Wu provided leadership to the Boeing corporate-wide Technical Fellowship Programs. Dr. Wu shared information with Boeing's national and international partners by working as Boeing technical leader, lecturing and presenting research papers to the industry.

Active in technical communities, he has served as conference chairman, keynote speaker, session chairman, and invited speaker for international meetings such as AIA, SAMPE, and other International Associations. He has established an industry-wide technical network for promoting advanced manufacturing processes.

Dr. Wu received his B.S. from Taiwan and Ph.D. in Polymer/Analytical Chemistry from University of Missouri-KC. He was a post-doctoral fellow at the University of Kansas. He has been very active with local universities and aerospace companies as an aerospace industry leader.

Dr. Wu was honored as Fellow at the Royal Aeronautical Society in June 2004. He received the 2002 Technical Excellence Award from The Nation Asian Professional Society and the 2006 Engineer of the Year Award from Asian American Engineer Society in the U.S.A.
